Uniting and growing

The planned and systematic journey of Kaunas University of Applied Sciences (Kaunas UAS) to the present fosters respect for its origins and inspires growth.

The origins of the institution go back to inter-war schools later transformed into technical schools that developed into schools of further education. Kauno kolegija was established on 1 September 2000, when the binary system of higher education was introduced in Lithuania. and the Kaunas Further Education Schools of Technology and Economics merged. These two schools had demonstrated the highest achievements at the national level and were granted the right to implement higher education studies. By 2003, the corporate structure of Kauno kolegija had been finalised, with the inclusion of further education institutions implementing the studies in landscaping, arts, medicine in Kaunas and Kėdainiai, Druskininkai and Taurage further education schools

implementing language, pedagogy, and other studies. Today, Kaunas UAS is concentrated in Kaunas and Tauragė.

By 2021, Kaunas UAS underwent meaningful and progressive transformation, integration, and recognition processes. In 2005, our institution was accredited by national external evaluation experts as an excellent-performing non-university higher education institution, and the international institutional evaluation in 2014 was also highly successful. In 2006, Kaunas UAS started implementing the first European Union-funded projects to improve study infrastructure. In 2010, international studies were launched. In 2011, Kaunas UAS was announced the best in the ranking of Lithuanian Universities of Applied Sciences by the national analytical publication "Veidas" and is among the leaders today. Kaunas UAS has been participating in the international *U-Multirank* of higher education institutions since 2013. In 2020.

it was among the 25 best-ranked higher education institutions in the category of relations with the labour market.

A major breakthrough took place in 2012, when the construction of the modern Kaunas UAS Library and Information Resource Centre was launched, symbolising the commencement of the academic campus located in the Kaunas Dainava District. The academic spaces continue to expand. In 2014-2020, around €10 million of various project funds were invested in the infrastructure and technical and software equipment. In 2020, our institution communicated an inspiration to join the international European Universities Alliance.

Achievements are attained through the ability of a large united professional and value-driven community of the academic and other staff, students, alumni, and social partners from Lithuania and abroad to respond to individual and societal needs.

The achievements we are proud of:

- the largest number of first-year students in Kaunas since 2016;
- every year since 2014, around **17** per cent of the students at the Lithuanian Universities of Applied Sciences study at Kaunas UAS;
- in the *U-Multirank* in 2020, our institution was among the top **25 higher education** institutions in the category of relations with the labour market;
- according to the data of the Lithuanian analytical education and higher education journal "Reitingai", Kaunas UAS has been among the top three leading universities of applied sciences in our country in the category of students and studies since 2018;
- the activities of the academic and other staff have been recognised in the public area; over 60 national and international awards have been granted since 2017;
- about **90 per cent** of the Kaunas UAS students rate the quality of teaching of the institution's academic staff very high.



Evidence of our growth:

- since Kaunas UAS was founded, about 31,000 graduates have entered the labour market;
- study programmes are implemented in 35 fields of study;
- **73 per cent** of study programmes have been accredited for the maximum period;
- 250 long-term cooperation agreements were concluded with social partners from Lithuania in the last five years;
- 218 Erasmus+ inter-institutional agreements have been signed with HEIs in almost 40 countries;
- students from almost **30** foreign countries were attracted for various types of studies, internships, and other study purposes in the last five years;

- the opportunity to study 12 foreign languages at different levels is provided;
- the number of international projects coordinated in 2016-2021 has increased
 4-fold compared to 2008-2013, and the participation as a partner more than
 3-fold;
- around **500** visual art events for Lithuanian and international communities over the last five years were organised;
- alumni activities have been formalised with the establishment of an association in 2014;
- around **€10 million** project funds were used to upgrade the infrastructure, hardware, and software in 2014-2020, the previous strategic period.

Fostering partnership and co-creation

Strong social partnerships considering the changing needs of the national and international labour market ensure the practical applicability of studies. Representatives of the business world and other stakeholders - students, graduates, staff - are involved in designing and improving study programmes and the study process itself.

The Kaunas UAS students recommend their Alma Mater as an institution that trains competent, civic, socially responsible, creative, and entrepreneurial professionals.



Focused on adaptability and interdisciplinarity

The studies in Kaunas UAS are characterised by the compliance of theoretical knowledge with practical skills. Studies of different fields are integrated, and the environment for acquiring a wide range of competencies is created, thus ensuring interdisciplinarity. Advanced teaching and learning methods are used to stimulate creativity, analytical thinking and are oriented towards meeting the challenges of the world of business and needs for its development. A lifelong learning ecosystem has been developed with the stakeholders to meet the needs of the world of activities. Students have the opportunity to have their internships in the most advanced national and international organisations. At least half of the Kaunas UAS staff are professional instructors-practicians. Competency-based modules/ courses can be studied flexibly, responding to the needs of the world of business and combining study with work. Not only professional competencies relevant to the workplace are developed but also citizenship, entrepreneurship, etc.


Open to technological progress, scientific and artistic innovation

New technologies are constantly being integrated into studies, and value-creating technological solutions are being applied. The study content is based on the latest research and art results, knowledge, and achievements. Competence-based studies use smart technologies to individualise the content and personalise learning. E-learning (teaching) is supported by well-developed digital infrastructure as a quality tool to ensure the accessibility of studies.

Kaunas UAS expands applied research, experimental development, and professional arts. This area serves as a basis for integrating innovation into studies. The researchers – academic staff and students - carry out applied research, projects, art activities and disseminate their findings with international partners. As a partner of the world of activity,

governmental and public organisations, Kaunas UAS conducts applied interdisciplinary research and performs experimental development in the fields of technology, biomedicine, social sciences, humanities, and agricultural sciences. It also carries out art activities focusing on creating health-friendly environments and advanced technologies; developing new products, services, and innovations in technology and art processes to solve the problems of society and the world of business. By integrating the entrepreneurial aspect into the content of studies and courses, an ecosystem for start-ups has been formed based on applied research, empowering the development and commercialisation of the solutions developed by the Kaunas UAS researchers.





Lifelong learning with responsibility

Kaunas UAS operates in a globally responsible way, following one of the European Union priorities - accelerating the transformation towards a climatefriendly economy. Sustainability is one of the core principles of corporate performance. The Kaunas UAS activities include socio-economic, environmental. and socio-cultural issues, with a strong focus on the circular economy in terms of studies, applied research, and other eco-innovations. Kaunas UAS bases its relations with stakeholders on the principles of respect for human beings, society, and the environment, academic and scientific ethics, and other values. Sustainable development is integrated into the content of the study programmes.

Kaunas UAS fosters a culture of performance improvement, characterised by continuous learning and effective (self) evaluation, which creates the conditions for appropriate decision-making. Kaunas UAS is perceived as a continuously learning organisation that ensures the targeted in-service training of its employees - instructors, researchers, and other staff. Learning and self-education are perceived as the right and duty of every community member. The community share their knowledge with other members. The focus is not only on recruiting new, talented, motivated, and inspiring academic and other staff but also on projecting the internal career development of the present staff. An effective system

for motivating staff has been developed to encourage them to achieve the highest levels of performance in the institution. The diversity in the Kaunas UAS community is respected, and the institution places great emphasis on assuring equal opportunities.


RESULTS TO BE ACHIEVED
