AIM:

To analyze students’ opinions on elective study courses and the
Quality of their teaching.

QUESTIONNAIRE:

The quality of elective study courses was evaluated based on 14 criteria. The
evaluation scale included the following options: *Strongly Agree; Agree;
Neither Agree nor Disagree; Disagree; Strongly Disagree.*
