## **REFERENCE PERIOD:**

From September 2024 to February 2025

### AIM:

To analyze International Business students' opinions on study modules and the Quality oh their teaching.

## **QUESTIONNAIRE:**

Students studying in the International Business study programme evaluated the quality of study modules based on 14 criteria. The evaluation scale included the following options: Strongly Agree; Agree; NeitherAgree nor Disagree; Disagree; Strongly Disagree.
